



**Malcolm Gillis, Ph. D.**  
**Economics Professor, Rice University**

The former President of Rice University, Malcolm Gillis, Ph. D. is now serving the school as a Professor of Economics. His research and teaching activities fall into two broad classes of national and international issues, fiscal reform and environmental policy.

Dr. Gillis has authored, co-authored or edited eight books including the leading textbook in its field, *Economics of Development* (4<sup>th</sup> edition) which is now available in five languages. He serves on many boards including the National Council for Science and the Environment, St. Luke's Episcopal Hospital, the Houston Symphony and AECOM Technology Corporation. He is also Chairman of the Board of BioHouston, Inc., a non-profit organization whose mission is to establish the Houston region as a vigorous global competitor in life science and biotechnology commercialization.

Dr. Gillis earned his Bachelor's Master's degrees from the University of Florida, and his Ph.D. from the University of Illinois.
