



**Dr. Atul Varadhachary**

Dr. Atul Varadhachary is a Houston-based Biotech and Life Sciences professional. He recently served as President and Chief Operating Officer of Agennix, Inc., a late-stage biotechnology company. Following a successful merger and the public listing of the company in 2010, Dr. Varadhachary stepped down from his position there. Prior to Agennix, he was a Senior Engagement Manager at McKinsey & Co.

Dr. Varadhachary co-founded and led Pratham Health (now the Niramaya Health Foundation), a preventive health program reaching 65,000 under-privileged children in India. He is also a founding director of Pratham USA; he serves on the Pratham Houston and Niramaya Boards and is President of Pratham USA. He has also been the IACCGH President.

In addition, Dr. Varadhachary sits on the Board of Managers of the Harris County Hospital District (HCHD) and is an Adjunct Professor at the Baylor College of Medicine and at the Jones Graduate School of Management at Rice University. And, he participates on the Life Sciences Advisory Committees of the Houston Technology Center.

Dr. Varadhachary received his M.D. from the University of Bombay, India. He also completed his Ph.D. in Physiology and a postdoctoral fellowship in Biological Chemistry at the Johns Hopkins School of Medicine in Baltimore.
