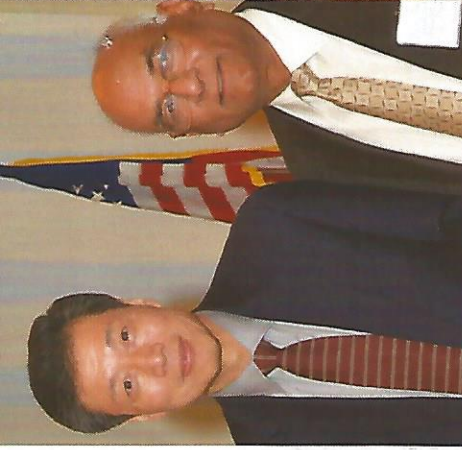
IACCGH DOCTORS RECEPTION
